# Meeting minutes for Shire of Owlsherst June 23, 2015

# **OFFICER'S REPORTS**

Seneschal – She reported she attended the Viking Thing, A&S nights, and Fiber day. We did not participate in the Girl Scout demo.

Exchequer – Presented 5 copies of the financial policy along with the bank balance.

Deputy Exchequer – Had nothing to report.

Knight's Marshal –Has submitted two years' worth of wavers to the kingdom and presented the shire with a list of loaner armor.

Arts & Sciences Minister – She reported she participated in several A&S events along with the Viking thing. She is seeking comments and suggestions from the shire to the A&S program.

Chatelaine – He reported he responded to several membership inquiries.

Chronicler – He reported he had posted the minutes from last month's minutes.

Deputy Chronicler –She has written an article on the Viking thing which will be included in the newsletter.

Herald – She reported that the consultation table at the Viking thing was busy.

Webminister – He reported he had followed up on a number of items for posting to the website. Minister of Lists – He submitted his report by email, ran the tournament at the Viking thing and sent the report to kingdom. He also did two reauthorizations at the event (Conall and Einnaar). In

addition the comment was made he did a good job at the Viking thing tournament.

## **OLD BUSINESS**
