OLD BUSINESS

Stamps - Widow Kait has received the stamps and they look good Shire Gathering - 6 - 8:15, Wednesday evenings

- Equipment Conall, has been asked by the church to clear excess shire items (primarily youth fighting items) from the stage. The items will be inventoried and excess items will be stored at Conall's as a temporary solution.
- PortaPotty Conall, suggested that the shire cover part of the cost for the PortaPotty that the church as incurred due to Covid and not being able to allow us to use the bathrooms inside during the summer practices. The

- amount suggested was \$110.00 which is one month's cost. Motion by Conall, second by Fabrisse all voted aye.
- Church payments, Orlaithe will be setting up a meeting between herself, Kalista and several other shire members to examine periodic payments to the church, perhaps on a quarterly basis for use of the church. This will be done prior to the next shire meeting and will be reported at that time if not sooner to the members of the shire.
- Safety Monitoring Cordeilla, she reported out on the results of the monitoring of the CO2 levels inside the church during practice using the newly purchased equipment. The results were good, at most times less than 800 ppm. If anyone is interested a more detailed report, please contact her or see her postings on social media or Yahoo. She did request an additional \$20.00 be allocated for the monitoring equipment which was approved by all. In addition, the room filter was assembled by Marcus and is in use in the classroom.

NEW BUSINESS

Revised mask policy for all gatherings. The new policy was presented and implantation at the shire level was discussed. For those who are not familiar with the policy here is how it appears in the East Kingdom Gazette along with a link for the full edition of same

• The Board of Directors has now given each Kingdom Seneschal, in consultation with their Crown, the authority to decide whether their Kingdom will require that all attendees at all in-person gatherings show proof of either full vaccination or a medically-supervised negative COVID test taken within 72 hours of the event. Proof of vaccine or a negative test shall not be required for children under 12. Children that are aged 3 through 11 shall wear a mask.

There was a lengthy discussion by all in attendance regarding the policy and how we will implement it at shire gatherings including practices. While the fine details are being worked out on the implementation process the following is a given:

- This policy will go into effect 10/12/21 for all shire gatherings
- The requirements will be enforced along with the requirement for mask wearing.
- Contact tracing will still be required for everyone.
- The shire officers ask that all attending events to please be respectful of these requirements and do their best to be flexible as these new mandates are implemented.
