Things that Went Well

I

- Calligraphy cards were extremely popular
- Gave out portable contact information to lots of people many of whom requested it
- · Food and beverages for participants
- · Large number of participants

Things that Didn't Go Well

- Multiple pre-existing interpersonal conflicts
- Boffers were left sitting in an accessible location (patrons picked them up and we had to intervene)
- At least one participant coming for the first time could not get information at the last minute (suggest organizing last-minute contact via phone/text/email. Note that Facebook is unreliable and should not be used later than 24-hours before demo start time.)
- · Insufficient advance planning for tent layout / location / number
- Out-of-Shire participants outnumbered in-Shire participants

Neutral Data Points

- · QR url pages visited by three different patrons all for the "martial arts" page
- Were contacted by a visitor requesting invitations to the email list and Discord server one
 week later because he and his brother had not been able to stop talking about meeting

Kaite would have liked to have a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for this sort of thing. Dunnie and Siobahn and Cordeilla can help on SOPs.
