## **OLD BUSINESS**

• Shire Storage- New location Found- Conall - Extra Space at the Galleria where the Bonton used to be. Can get a 10 x 5 \$16 a month for 6 months. He will pay ahead. Inside, climate controlled, clean. \$29 administrative fee up front. After 6 months look at market price (right now is \$42). They do not demand insurance. Conall's homeowner's covers, with the exception of water damage from a sprinkler if triggered.

Have an end date of October 31st of Prime storage and must be out by November 4th.

Office closes at 6 PM, so move-in needs to begin before that so he can pay. So far Wulfgar, Conall, Cordeilla and maybe Dunnie, Gerhard and Hans for moving. Wulfgar has a trailer they can use. Conall will post the moving day.

QUESTION - has inquiry been made related to our non-profit status for fee. ANSWER: It has not. Conall can check

NOTE: we are currently paying \$91 a month.

- Food, Fiber Forestry and Fun Recap Seraphina we had 48 attendees, \$668.51 made. Everyone had a good time. Food was good. Seraphina is moving at the end of November.
   Sarra there was a communication on our FFFF vs. Aethelmarc FFF (fiber event)
- By-Laws KIngdom is asking to resubmit bylaws for review -Kingdom would like us to resubmit a copy to them. Cordeilla will work with Gerhard
- Insurance Form for Church Gerhard was able to get guidance from a template on SCA.org that can be submitted to the Board of Directors. There is a fee to submit Cordeilla - Hartshorndale gets a blanket for every Sunday, could talk to them for example.
- 12th Night Cordeilla is making site tokens 1.5 inch double sided. Target is 125 pieces. Kingdom accepted a bid for Kingdom 12th night in New Hampshire on the 18th. Elevation is to occur at Mudthaw.

Contacted Duchess Diana to run a dance. Would like to start meetings in November to discuss events. Orlaithe is researching Roman. Siobahn will be at Wednesday for subtle discussion. Will return to format of fighting indoors

The Inn of the White Cat is haunted by the ghost of a white cat who howls whenever there is no music! So tavern-goers can be sure to hear plenty of music all day long, and can contribute their own songs and music, or sponsor musicians to add to the fun. Cards, dice, and period game instructions at each table will give attendees other avenues for entertainment, and there should be space for small handcrafts as well. A rolling dayboard of hearty, simple, tavern-style food served intermittently throughout the day will keep folks sated. The site allows alcohol, and in addition to the usual BYOB, brewers are encouraged to bring their brews for tasting.

The proposed site is a converted barn. The main hall has wood floors, big beams, and a serving bar that will work well to emulate a tavern counter. We intend to decorate the main Tavern area with faux fireplace, the White Cat, and atmospheric electric candle lighting to keep the tavern atmosphere as much as possible.

Lower floor has a smaller room with a kitchenette where the food prep can take place. There are restrooms. Both floors are accessible, though you have to go outside in order to go between the two if using a wheelchair.

NOTE: All fees for the Lower Allen Township Barn for 2025 have not yet been determined, though they should not differ greatly from prices for this year. I have guessed at the possible rise in price.

As a non-profit organization, we are eligible to receive the lower, Resident pricing, which is great! We will need to prove our 501(3)c status.

Since there is no off-board for this event, it is not easily made affordable for families, unfortunately.

Security Deposit \$300.00 (Returned after event) Alcohol Deposit \$140.00 (Guard paid from this)

All fees do not include the extra \$10 non-member charge to Corporate.

75 adults x \$20 = \$1500

Budget would allow for up to 8 musicians who committed to performing for ½ an hour apiece to receive a \$10 discount on their event fee (covers the food costs). This would be above the 75 attendees.

Event Fee could be raised to \$22 per adult, if the shire felt concerned about breaking even or making money; I have concerns about getting full attendance at that rate.

Mael Eoin here to explain the tavern event that he has run.
 QUESTION - How was the event kitchen set - Mael Eion Answer - rolling food all day. Have people place their order at the bar.
 Kitchen announces for example 'soup is ready' and cold things available.
